



MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER
RESCINDING THE AUGUST 21, 2021 EXECUTIVE ORDER
WITH REGARD TO THE WEARING OF MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS IN INDOOR SETTINGS
AND AT CERTAIN OUTDOOR GATHERINGS

October 26, 2021

Whereas, Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford and Chapter 517 of the Connecticut General Statutes confer upon the Mayor emergency powers to deal with public health emergencies, such as the global pandemic of COVID-19, to ensure that preparations of the City will be adequate to deal with the emergency, and to preserve the lives and property of the citizens of Stamford; and

Whereas, Section 82-8a of the Connecticut General Statutes empowers the mayor to take such action as he deems necessary to mitigate the emergency; and

Whereas Mayor David R. Martin issued the August 10, 2021, Executive Order Mandating the Wearing of Masks or Face Coverings in Indoor Settings and at Certain Outdoor Gatherings.

Now, therefore, I, David R. Martin, Mayor of the City of Stamford, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the City of Stamford and the State of Connecticut do hereby rescind the August 10, 2021, Executive Order that reads:

“Effective 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 12, 2021, it shall be required that masks or face coverings be worn in all indoor areas of any place of public accommodation including but not limited to retail businesses, restaurants and bars, within the City of Stamford, by all persons regardless of vaccination status. Masks are required at all outdoor gatherings of more than 100 persons at City of Stamford facilities or parks. An exemption from the outdoor event mask mandate may be granted in the discretion of the Office of Public Safety, Health and Welfare upon presentation by the promoter or event organizer to the City of an appropriate alternative safety plan.”
