<p>Maria Millan, Outreach Worker</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Access Health CT</i></p>	<p>Ms. Millan presented an overview of the new Access Health CT insurance program.</p> <p>Access Health CT insurance program helps CT residents enroll in health care coverage. October 1, 2013 – March 31, 2014 was the first open enrollment period.</p> <p>Ms. Millan is a registered Assister for the AHCT program and together with a seasonal employee they enrolled over 900 people during the enrollment period.</p> <p>Ms. Millan talked about the process of enrolling a family and or an individual; she also distributed copies of information about the Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA), particularly discussing the “Lawfully Present” section of the ACA.</p> <p>There was a discussion about the website for people who want to sign up and not see an Assister or a</p>
