He was re-trained as a heavy weapons infantryman and during his 13-month tour of duty and he advanced to gunner and squad leader. He then spent 5 months assigned to the 2nd Battalion of the 50th Infantry in the 2nd Armored Division in Ft. Hood, Texas. Al's last duty assignment was with the 3rd Battalion of the 60th Infantry in the 9th Infantry Division, which was stationed in the Mekong Delta in the Republic of Vietnam.

Stories and Recollections:

My dad was called to active duty on August 6th, 1943. Throughout high school he had studied aviation and wanted to join the Air Corps. He went to Fort Benning, Georgia for infantry basic training. He passed all the tests for the Air Corp with flying colors however, he was rejected from the Air Corp due to his eye site. Instead, they sent him to an Army Specialized Training Program (ASTP) at Princeton University where he studied to become an aeronautical mechanic. He studied engineering at Princeton until the evening of February 18, 1954. That evening they heard that the college program ASTP was being immediately discontinued. Transfers to the Air Corp were banned and my dad was immediately sent to Camp Carson, Colorado for basic training. He was trained to use various infantry weapons and used an M-1 in combat. He was then assigned to a rifle company in an Infantry regiment and sent overseas. In September of 1943 his squad was guarding supply train in Paris which was still under a blackout. They then had a brief tour of Paris with the USO. Shortly thereafter he was sent into combat. He then fought in Belgium, Holland and Germany. On November 19, 1944 his Sargent was injured, and my dad volunteered to go find the medics. He found the field hospital to alert them about his Sargent. On the way back to his regiment he stepped on an antipersonnel mine and crawled his way back to the medics. My dad left Liverpool England at 10 am January 20, 1945 and arrived in Charleston, SC at 9:30 am on February 8, 1945. He was then transferred to Wakeman General and Convalescent Hospital in Camp Atterbury, Indiana. He remained in the hospital until November 8, 1945. After my dad retired every Veteran's Day and Memorial Day he would go to the local schools in Stamford and relay stories about his time in the service.
