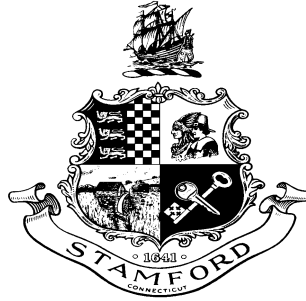

Additional Appropriation for the Purchase of Body-worn Cameras and Digital Storage Equipment

<i>Item 2</i>	Request for Approval of Additional Appropriation for the purchase of 161 body-worn cameras and digital storage equipment through an award from the US Bureau of Justice Assistance. The award provides \$338,000 to the City of Stamford and \$262,000 to the City of Bridgeport. The grant requires a 1:1 local match of \$338,000. \$200,000 has been requested in the 2016/17 operating budget and a \$138,000 appropriation is being requested from contingency funds. This request was placed on the April 14, 2016 Board of Finance agenda and held so more information could be presented.
