1. The meeting was called to order by Committee Chairman Karp at approximately 5:31 p.m.

2. Review and Approval of November 1, 2021 Meeting Minutes.

Commissioner Abernethy moved to approve November 1, 2021 Meeting Minutes. Seconded by Commissioner Ortelli Unanimously Approved

3. LWRD License Application Pre-Submission Consultation Form -- HMC -- Eric Jensen, 236 Davenport Driver, Stamford, CT. Removal of authorized ramp and floating dock, and construction of piling-supported 4' by 36' pier, 3' by 34' ramp and 8' by 20' piling-anchored floating dock for improved recreational boat docking. John Hilts, applicant's representative, was present to explain project and answer commissioner's questions.

Commissioner Ortelli made a motion to recommend to the HMC a finding of no objection to the pre-application plans being included in a permit application to DEEP, with the understanding that the HMC reserves its right to continue to review the proposal.

4. LWRD License Application Pre-Submission Consultation Form – Shellfish Commission -- Eric Jensen, 236 Davenport Driver, Stamford, CT. Removal of authorized ramp and floating dock, and construction of piling-supported 4' by 36' pier, 3' by 34' ramp and 8' by 20' piling-anchored floating dock for improved recreational boat docking. John Hilts, applicant's representative, was present to explain project and answer commissioner's questions.

Commissioner Ortelli made a motion to recommend to the HMC a finding of no objection to the pre-application plans being included in a permit application to DEEP, with the understanding that the HMC, acting as the Shellfish Commission, reserves its right to continue to review the proposal.

Seconded by Commissioner Abernethy

5. Referral of CSPR 1122 – Eric and Marie Jensen, 236 Davenport Drive, Stamford, CT. Applicant requests the approval of a Coastal Site Plan Review Application to undertake substantial renovations to an existing residence, including construction of outdoor terraces, in-

ground pool and pool pavilion, and pickle ball court as well as drainage improvements, landscaping, and other related site work. Brian P. McMahon, P.E., Redniss & Mead, was present to explain the project and answer the commissioners' questions. As described, the proposed project is expected to significantly improve storm water conditions on the project site through establishment of a storm water collection and infiltration system designed to comply with and exceed the requirements of the Stamford Drainage Manual.

Commissioner Ortelli made a motion to recommend to the HMC a finding of consistency with the Harbor Management Plan provided the Engineering Bureau determines compliance with all City storm water management requirements and all FEMA requirements for coastal construction and to also recommend support for a maintenance agreement as a condition of project approval to ensure continued maintenance of the proposed storm water management system by the owner.

Seconded by Commissioner Abernethy

6. Referral of CSPR 1123 - The Woodway Country Club, Inc., 95 Hobson Street, Stamford, CT. The proposed project is a new detached/elevated terrace at 2,532 sq. ft.; new southwest detached/open pavilion at 1,200 sq. ft.; and new northeast detached/open pavilion at 1,000 sq. ft. Tessa Jucaite, P.E, TJ Engineering, and Design R. Architects, LLP, was present to explain the project and answer the commissioners' questions. As described, the proposed project will maintain existing site runoff conditions and includes no new storm water management measures.

Commissioner Ortelli made a motion to recommend to the HMC a finding of no objection to this application provided the Engineering Bureau determines compliance with all City storm water management requirements and all FEMA requirements for coastal construction.

- SBL project application update. Chairman Ortelli reported that Land-Use Bureau Chief Ralph Blessing has informed the HMC that the applicant's previously submitted applications to the Planning Board and Zoning Board have been withdrawn. Any new

submittals will be referred by the Land-Use Bureau to the HMC for review according to the requirements of the General Statutes and City Code.
