 - A. State Project 135-331 Bridge #01350 Rehabilitation (Route 137 over <u>Rippowam River</u>): Concrete T-beam bridge (1939) is 250' north of the Merritt Parkway and near the "Turn of the River" lenticular truss bridge that is listed on the National Register.
 - B. State Project 135-332 Bridge #04067 Replacement (Cedar Heights Road over Rippowam River): This project has been previously reviewed by SHPO and determined to have an Adverse Effect to Historic Properties.
 - C. State Project 135-334 Bridge #00032 Rehabilitation (I-95 over Metro North RR): This bridge was constructed in 1958 and is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.
 - **D.** State Project 135-336 South State Street Rehabilitation: The project will rehabilitate an 1848 masonry arch bridge. OEP staff determined the bridge is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.
