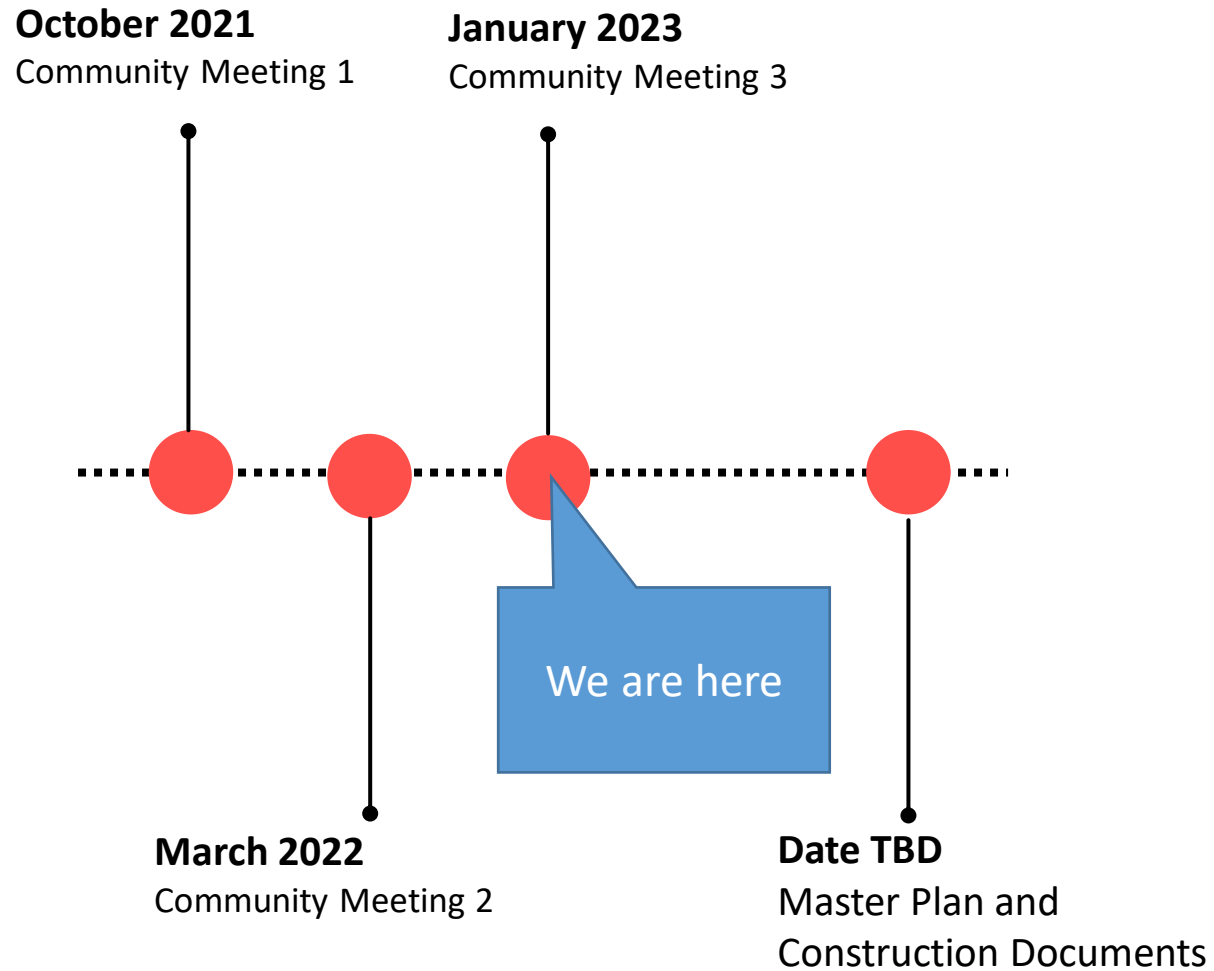

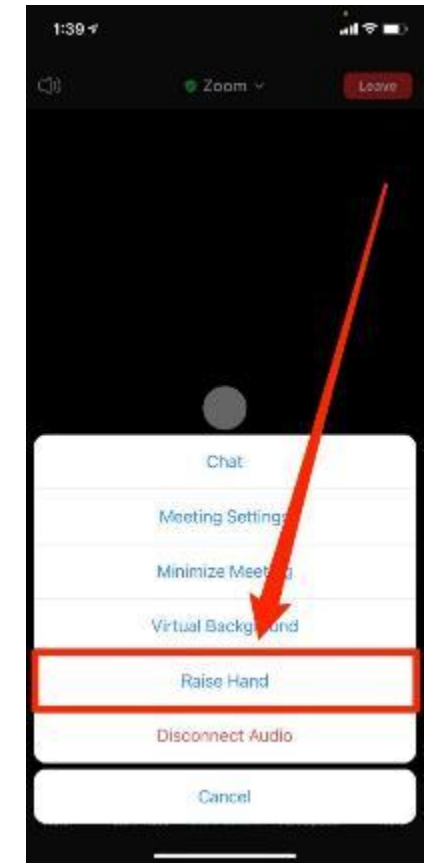
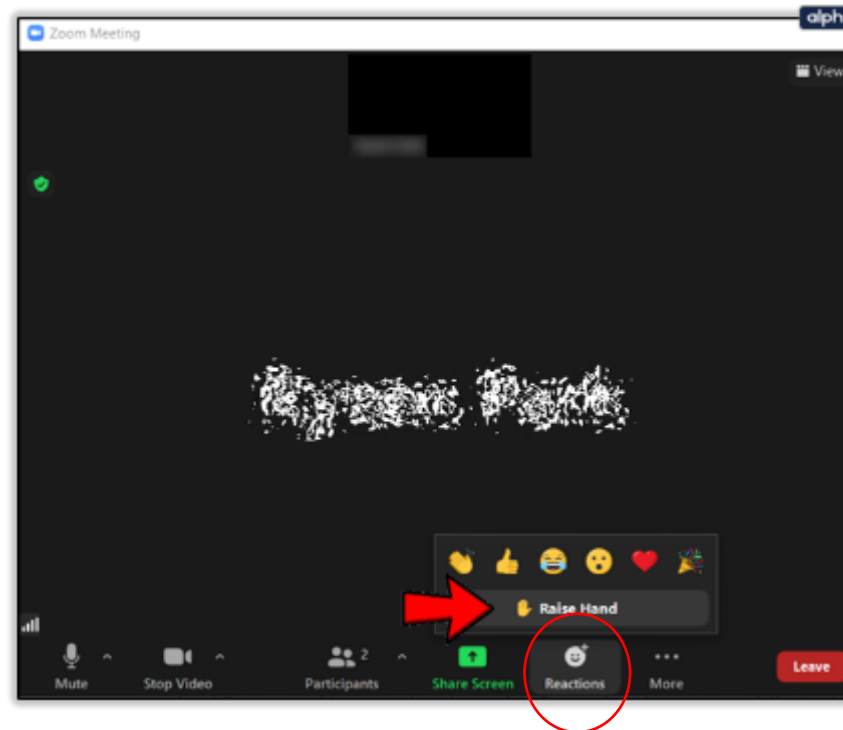

Playground Improvement Plan

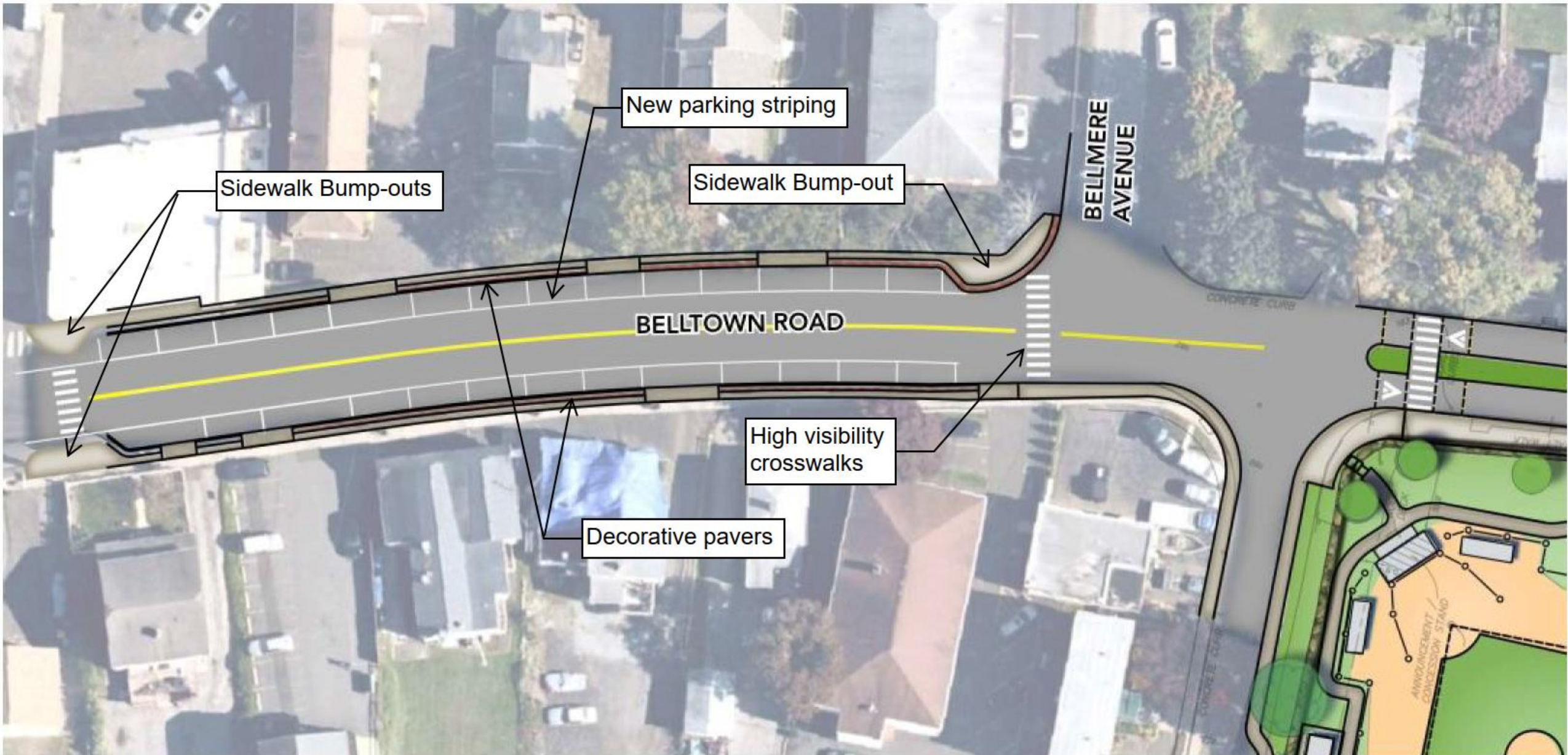
- 2-5 & 5-12 play areas, Appropriate surfacing

- Site fencing (if appropriate)

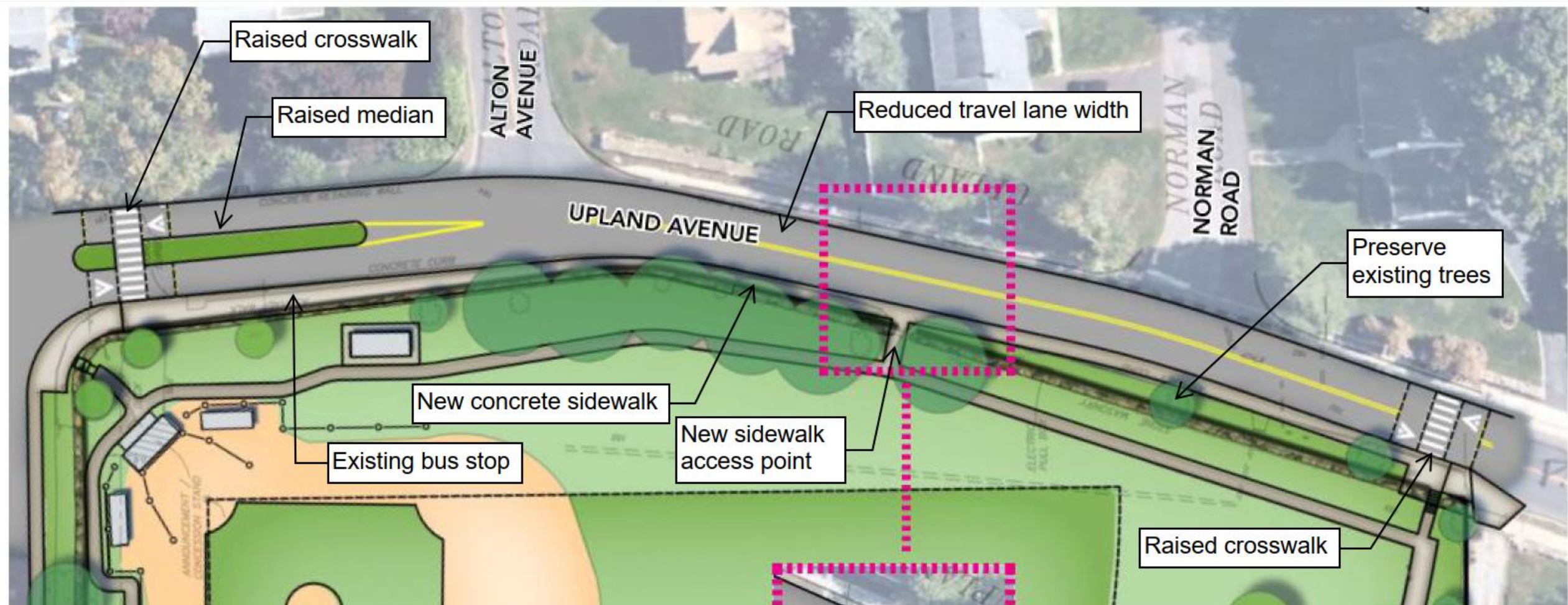

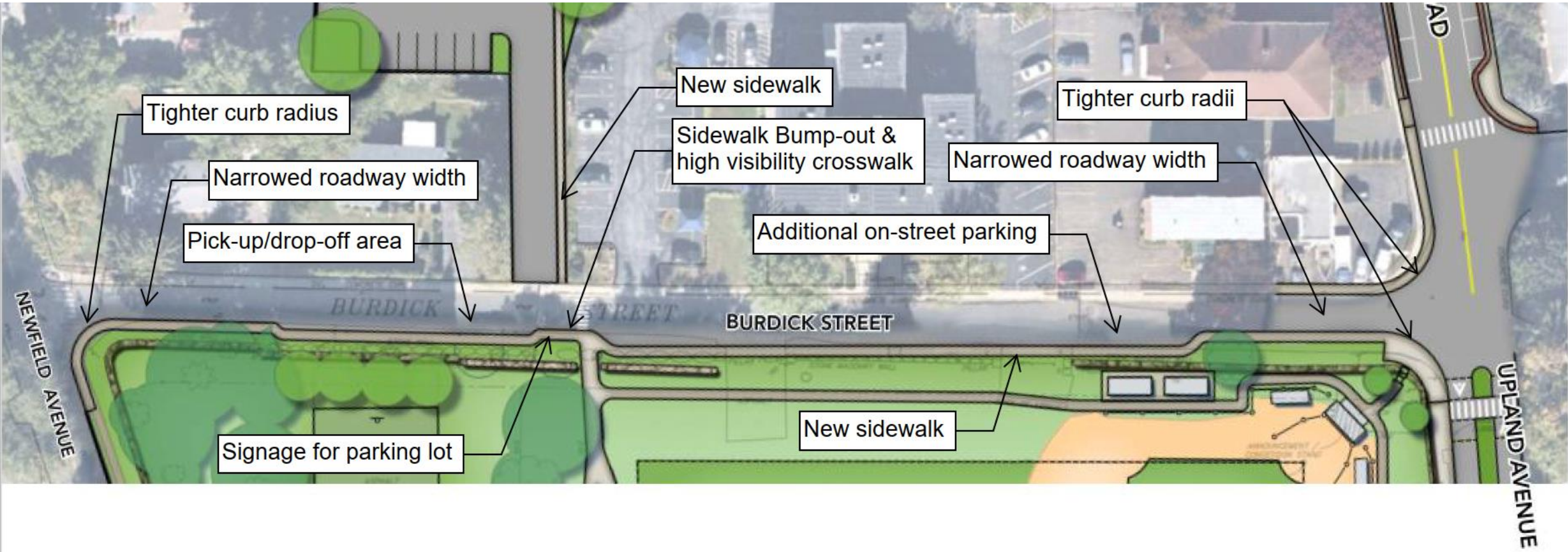




Roadway Concept

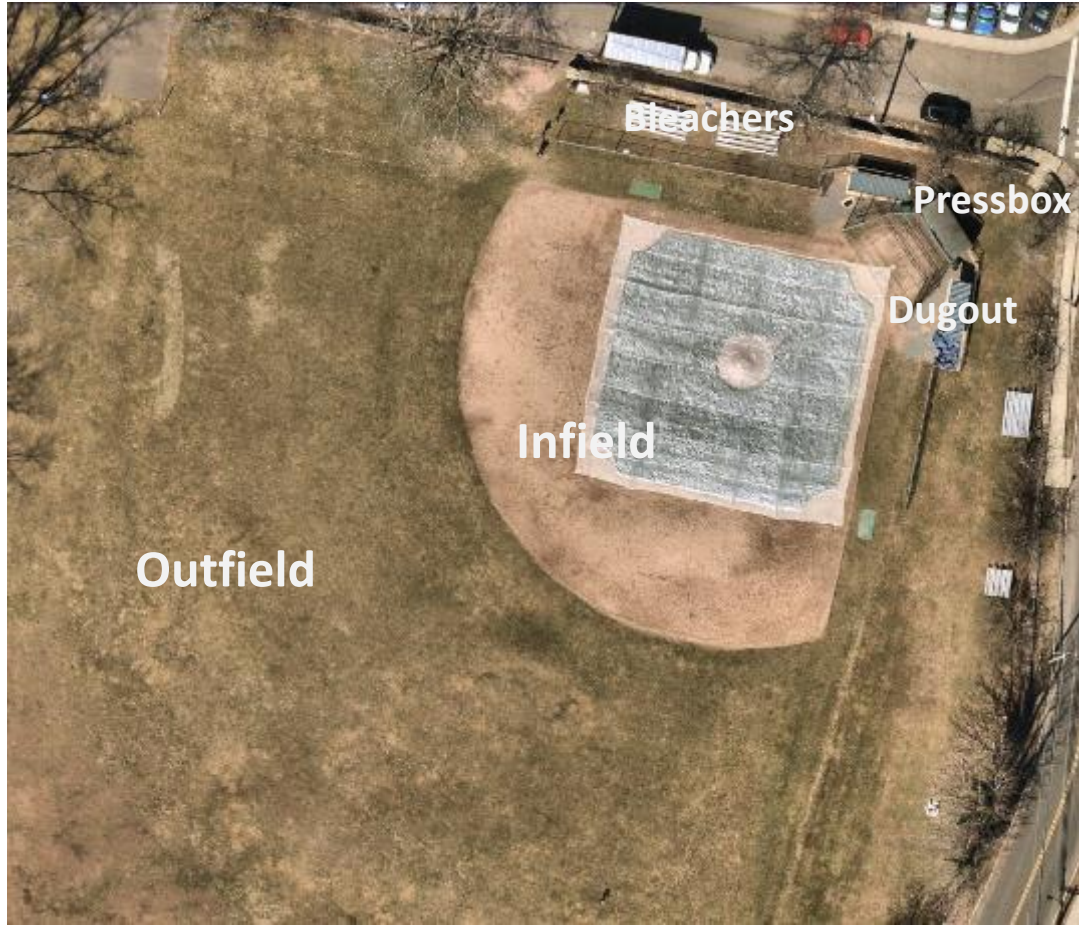

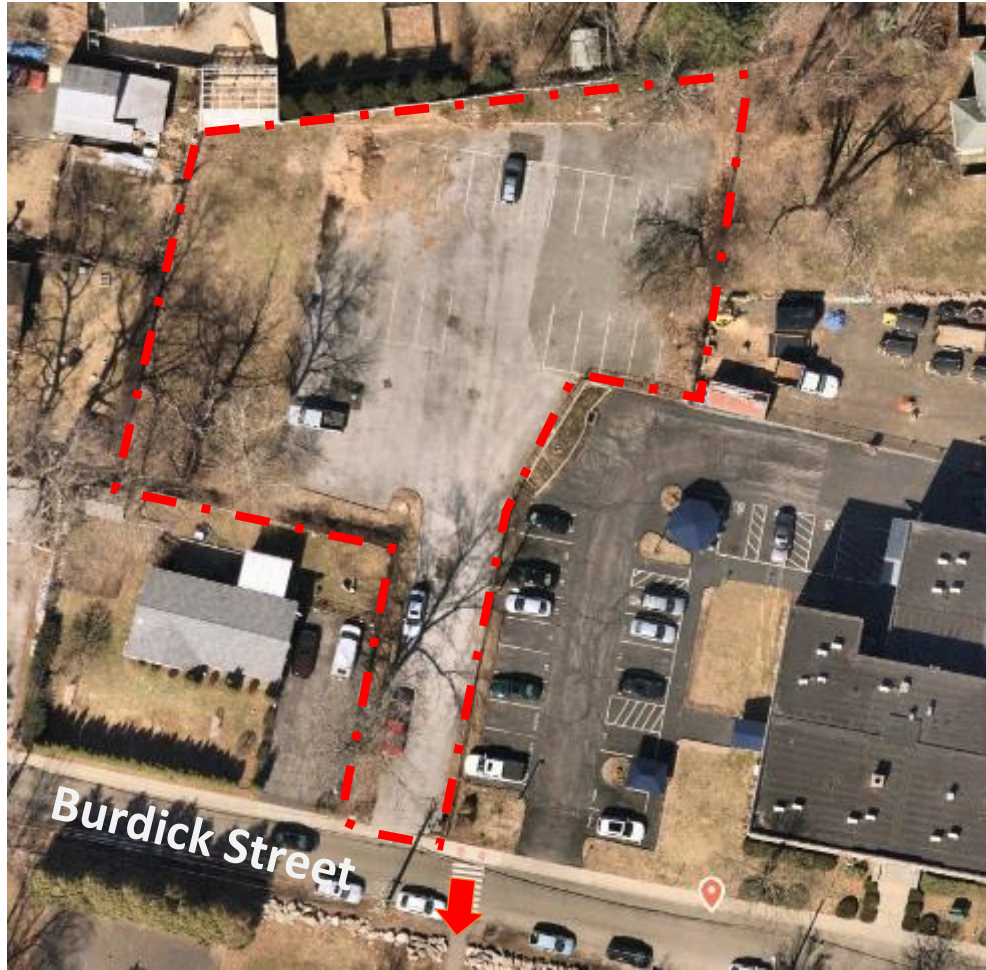

Goals (In Order of Priority):

Develop new playground

1. Evaluate and renovate existing restrooms
2. Provide additional seating and recycling/trash units along walks
3. Provide lighting along entries
4. Accessible ramp to restrooms, expand landing area as needed
5. Develop path around park
6. Enhance neighborhood connection at Newfield Ave.
7. Invasive species management
8. Provide splash pad
9. Evaluate and renovate pavilion
10. Inspect irrigation system and update as needed.
11. Rebuild walls along Newfield Ave.
12. Rebuild walls along Burdick St.
13. Provide continued lawn improve. Infield/outfield
14. Improve basketball court
15. Widen existing walk from 5 to 8 feet
16. Enhance baseball field with new fence mesh, bleachers and bleached pads, update dugouts and press-box
17. Incorporate fitness areas along walk
18. Adjust location of entry sign
19. Repair the scoreboard
