The Transportation, Traffic & Parking Department (TTP) has reviewed the following documents:

- Planning Board application received November 10, 2022;
- Project narrative;
- Traffic Impact Study Prepared by KWH Enterprise, LLC;
- Preliminary Subdivion Map prepared by Redniss and Mead dated October 28, 2022; and
- Site Development Plan prepared by Redniss and Mead dated October 28th, 2022.

Based on the above documents, the Department has the following comments.

Traffic Study

1. The study should include a crash data analysis of the adjacent roadways and intersections.

Site Development Plan

- 1. The sidewalk shall be carried flush across the driveway apron. An easement may be required to facilitate this.
- 2. The Department recommends including private road signage and/or dead end signage at the entrance to indicate the dead end and private road designation of the driveway.
- 3. The Sidewalk shall have ADA tactile warning pads before crossing the driveway
- 4. The stop sign shall be 30"
- 5. Include CTDOT sign post detail
- 6. If the electrical service from the utility pole to the transformer requires trenching in the sidewalk, then that entire section of sidewalk shall be replaced in kind.
- 7. An excavation permit will be required for all work in the City Right of Way
- 8. A construction parking and operations management plan will be required for the issuance of a building permit. There shall be no queuing or parking of vehicles on or any impact to the City Right of Way.
- 9. Show a turning movement template for a ladder fire truck to enter the driveway.
