Lack of funding has necessitated breaking Phase 1 of the renovation (the beachfront) into smaller construction projects, which costs significantly more money. We are pleased to provide this scope and fee proposal for construction administration services for the Cummings Park Phase 1 Improvements. The following represents our understanding of the construction administration scope and the services that will be performed by Stantec Consulting Services Inc.

Scope

Stantec will provide construction administration services for the project duration which is anticipated to be approximately eight (8) months. Services for this scope shall include the following:

- Review of contractor material submittals and shop drawings for compliance with construction drawings;
- Review and respond to contractor RFI's;
- Prepare field sketches in response to RFIs if needed and due to unforeseen field condition. Field sketches shall be included in a conformance set of construction drawings by the contractor to inform final set of record drawings;
- Attend two (2) construction progress and/or field issue meetings and prepare field reports.
- One (1) site visit for preparation of punch list;
- One (1) site visit to verify completion of punch list items;
- Stantec shall review contractor's final requisition for payment;
- Assist the City with project close-out by attesting to completion of punch-list;
- CSPR 1146 Compliance
 - Submission of certification by a Connecticut professional engineer that the design of all new structures (e.g., tensile shade structures) and all new fixtures (e.g., trash receptacles)

are compliant with the provisions of the "Flood Prone Area Regulations" (Section 15.B of the Zoning Regulations) and are capable of withstanding the flood depths, pressures, velocities, impact and uplift forces and other factors associated with the base flood. For items being designed by vendor, certification will be provided by them.

- Submission of a written protocol detailing the forecast conditions that will prompt the project contractor to remove stockpiled material and other unsecured items from the velocity flood zone during construction.
- All landscaping shall be implemented under the supervision of a qualified landscape professional and certified as completed (signed/lettered) prior to EPB staff authorization for issuance of a certificate of occupancy/completion. (Limited to one Stantec site visit during installation.)

The above scope assumes the city will have a project representative available for interim site visits, to coordinate with Stantec on construction items, and to monitor and confirm measurements for payment.

Special Conditions / Assumptions / Exclusions

The following services are excluded and deemed not necessary for this Scope of Services:

- SWPPP Permit Inspections or Compliance Visits
- Redesign of proposed improvements due to changes in scope
- Design or reporting for management of contaminated soils
- Soil testing, handling, and disposal (to be procured by City of Stamford)
- As-built Survey
- Structural Design
- Permitting
