Caller: Hello?

PSD: 911, what is the address of your emergency?

C: I need you here and I'm gonna press charges!

PSD: Where is here?

C: [REDACTED]

PSD: Is there an apartment? Hello?

C: No, a house. [REDACTED]

PSD: Ok, what's happening there?

C: Enough is enough

PSD: Hello?

C: Hello? Yes

PSD: What's happening?

C: This man that lives here, Steven Barrier, he is a menace to society and I'm ready to press charges because he almost

PSD: you have to stop yelling please, I don't understand you when you're yelling

C: I'm so upset you need to get here now

PSD: You need to calm down so that I can understand what you're saying, ok?

C: yes I got into a fight with this boy because he is a problem and I'm ready to press charges because he needs to be locked up

PSD: was it a physical altercation?

C: yes this is a physical, he punched me in my face, hit me in my face, hit me with a broom, everything. He needs to be in jail.

PSD: OK, are you injured?

C: Yeah, I'm not injured, I'm ok, I'm... I don't know. I don't know if I'm injured anyway because right now I'm shaking...

PSD: Ok what is your name?

C: My name is [REDACTED]

PSD: [REDACTED] and who is this person to you?

C: He's [REDACTED], Steven Barrier

PSD: What's his name, Steven... spell his last name?

C: B-A-R-R-I-E-R.

C: No, no, enough is enough.

PSD: Does he live there?

C: He lives here and he's been a problem. You should look at the record how many times my [REDACTED] called.

PSD: How old is Steven?

C: he's a grown man, 24, 23 turning, (in background "23 tomorrow") yeah, 23 tomorrow. Yes, grown man.

PSD: Are there any weapons in the house [REDACTED]?

C: No, but he has the broom sticks using as a weapon

PSD: stay on the phone with me, where is Steven right now?

C: He ran downstairs, he maybe ran outside, we don't know. But you know, we're not gonna go down there because you know he may [REDACTED].

PSD: Ok, is this a private home or is this an apartment?

C: It's a private home.

PSD: Ok so give me a description of Steven. Black, white, Hispanic? Give me a clothing description.

C: He's black, he's tall, he's wearing a sweater, like a blue sweater right? I saw, yeah that was a sweater and a tshirt, blue jeans.

PSD: He has on a.. [REDACTED], you need to calm down. He has on a blue sweater?

C: Yes

PSD: ok and what color are the pants

C: it's white, right?

(In the background): he's wearing a white tshirt

C: He's wearing a white tshirt, a blue sweater, I don't even know what he had on.

PSD: So he's downstairs, is he still in the house? Or is he outside of the house.

C: We don't know like I said. We don't know, he ran downstairs, he may be still down there, or he may have ran outside through the back door. We don't know.

C: He cannot... No you see what he was doing-

PSD: Ok [REDACTED]?

C: (aside, to someone else in the house) Yeah... no. No. Mental? He's not mental. Steven knows what he's doing. No mental person should do that! Exactly! I'm gonna press charges because enough. He's gonna hurt everybody in here.

PSD: Ok [REDACTED]

C: Mhm?

PSD: [REDACTED] how many people are in the house now?

C: it's me [REDACTED]
[REDACTED].

PSD: You've got a house full of people there.

C: Yes

PSD: and you don't know if he's in the house downstairs or outside, you don't know?

C: yeah because nobody goes down there but him and again, we're not... we don't know if he

PSD [REDACTED], when you say nobody goes down there but him, where is down there? Would that be the basement of the house?

C: Down in the attic, no I mean basement, it's the basement

PSD: It's the basement, okay and is there an exit through the basement?

C: yes, there's an exit, that's right, so he could easily run through the back door down there.

(Dispatcher, aside, calling over to the radio): Hey Heather? He may be in the basement area – the basement area has an exit door.

C: yes, the basement has an exit door the police can easily go to the back and go to that door it's open

PSD: Ok. Just stay on the phone with me until the uh, until you make contact with the officers. Does he drive a vehicle? Do you know?

C: No, he doesn't.

PSD: No vehicle? Do you know his date of birth?

C: it's October 23, 1996.

PSD: Okay and when you spell his name is it S-T-E-P-H-E-N or is it S-T-E-V-E-N

C: It's S-T-E-V-E-N, yes

PSD: Okay. We have the officers-

C: They're here

PSD: are you with the officers?

C: yes, they are here

PSD: okay I'm gonna disconnect the call

C: thank you
