ABSENTEE BALLOT GUIDELINES

How can I obtain an AB application?

- a. Request your AB Application online: <https://oabr-sots.ct.gov/OABR/absenteeBallotReqPortalHome.do>
- b. Download the application here: [AB Application](#), or
- c. Send email to townclerk@stamfordct.gov to request that an AB application be mailed to you directly.
- d. Call (203)977-5280 to request an AB application; please provide your name and address when you leave a message.

Who qualifies for an AB ballot?

- a. In CT, voters need to provide a valid reason to qualify for an AB ballot. You must mark one of the reasons provided on the AB application form.

Where can I return the Application for an AB ballot?

- a. **Drop off** in the **ballot box** in the parking garage in the Government Center; or the **ballot box** in front of the Harry Bennett Library (Vine Rd). The boxes are accessible 24 hours a day.
- b. **Mail to:** Town Clerk - P.O. Box 891, Stamford, CT 06904-0891
- c. Please note, **electronic copies are not accepted** as per Connecticut Law.

When will the ballots be available?

- The ballots will be sent out starting **February 13, 2024.**

Where can I return the Ballot?

- a. **Drop off** in one of the **ballot boxes**, located in the parking garage in the **Government Center**, and in front of the **Harry Bennett Library** (Vine Rd). The boxes are accessible 24 hours a day.
- b. **Mail to:**Town Clerk, P.O. Box 891, Stamford, CT 06904-0891

What's the last date/time to drop off my ballot?

- a. Ballots need to be received in our office via US mail by Primary Day, March 5, 2024, to be counted.
- b. The final collection of ballots from the ballot boxes is at 8pm on March 5, 2024.
