Pursuant to emergency powers as set forth in Connecticut General Statute Section 28-8a and Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford, I hereby issue the following Executive Order.

## MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER RE: SUSPENDING THE REQUIREMENTS OF STAMFORD CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 97-10 "CITY EMPLOYEES DESIGNATED AS CIVIL CITATION OFFICERS"

Whereas, Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford and Chapter 517 of the Connecticut General Statutes confer upon the Mayor emergency powers to deal with public health emergencies, such as the global pandemic of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), to ensure that preparations of the City will be adequate to deal with the emergency, and to preserve the lives and property of the residents of Stamford; and.

Whereas, on March 11, 2020, Mayor David Martin declared a Public Health and Local Civil Preparedness Emergency in the City of Stamford; and

Whereas, Section 28-8a of the Connecticut General Statutes empowers the mayor to take such action as he deems necessary to mitigate the emergency; and

Whereas, it is in the City's interests to employ additional Civil Citation Officers to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

- 1. Effective Thursday, November 19, 2020, the requirements in Stamford Code of Ordinances Section 97-10, requiring that individuals appointed as Civil Citation Officers by the Mayor be approved by the Board of Representatives, are hereby suspended.
- 2. This order will expire upon the cessation of the Declaration of Public Health and Local Civil Preparedness Emergency.
