



Pursuant to emergency powers as set forth in Connecticut General Statute Section 28-8a and Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford, I hereby issue the following Executive Order.

**MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER
RE: CLOSING OF PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS**

Whereas, Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford and Chapter 517 of the Connecticut General Statutes confer upon the Mayor emergency powers to deal with public health emergencies, such as the global pandemic of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19), to ensure that preparations of the City will be adequate to deal with the emergency, and to preserve the lives and property of the residents of Stamford; and.

Whereas, on March 11, 2020, Mayor David Martin declared a Public Health and Local Civil Preparedness Emergency in the City of Stamford; and

Whereas, Section 28-8a of the Connecticut General Statutes empowers the mayor to take such action as he deems necessary to mitigate the emergency; and

Whereas, public swimming pools can attract numbers of people that violate the guidelines on social distancing, endangering the health and safety of the residents of Stamford.

1. Effective immediately, all public swimming pools are closed; and
2. This order will expire upon the cessation of the Declaration of Public Health and Local Civil Preparedness Emergency.
