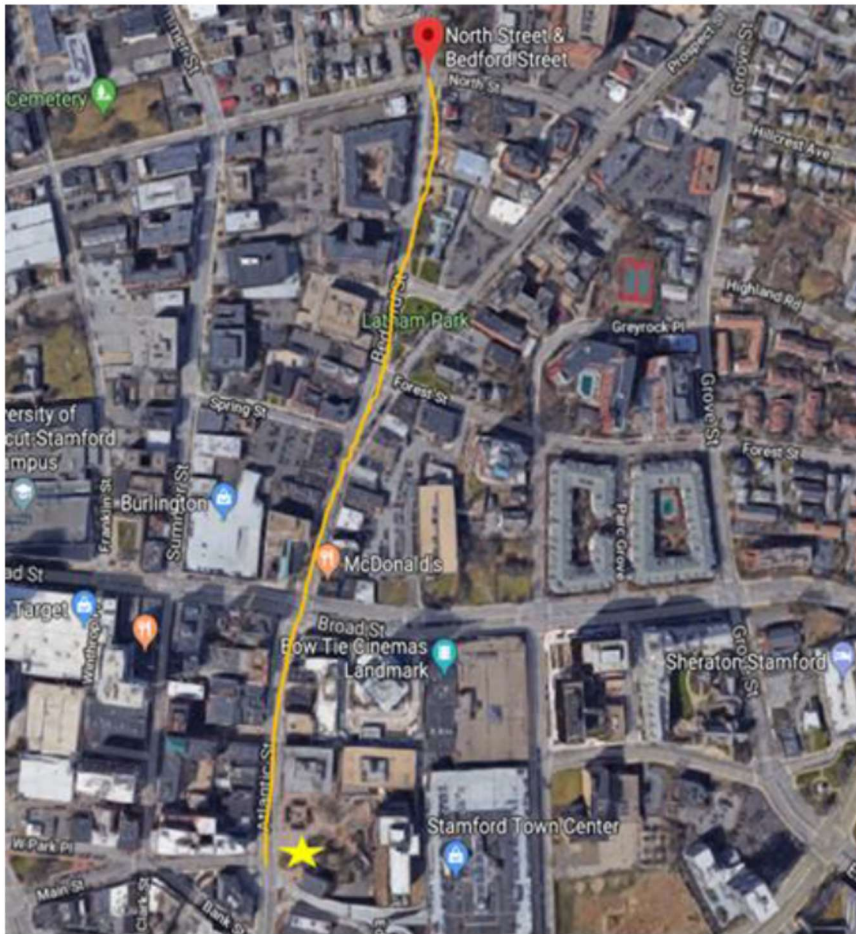
New items:
